Dear Bro Secretaries,

The Province of Essex were delighted to be chosen as the hosts for the 13th National Masonic Championships, which will take place one week before the Tercentenary of the first English Grand Lodge, and to ensure an enjoyable event for all classes of shooter we've chosen the West London Shooting School (an easily accessible 65 acre ground) to host the championships; (twice voted best shooting ground in the country).

It's an easy location to get to being located just off the M4 and close to the M25. (See directions on Page 5)

A layout of the ground is attached at Page 6 and the entry forms are attached at Page 7 & 8.

In 2016 our Province was the first to launch a Festival for the benefit of the new Masonic Charitable Foundation (MCF), which will end in 2022. There will be a raffle on the day with all proceeds going to *Festival 2022*. We thank you in advance for your support.




The West London Shooting School is a prestigious ground but we managed to negotiate a reduced fee, which allowed us to keep the cost to much the same as many of the recent National Championships. The total cost of the event is £80.00 per person, which includes:


- Tea/coffee and bacon roll on arrival
- 100 target ESP course over 14 refereed stands
- 2 course barbecue lunch, (please advise of any dietary requirements) including
- 2 soft drinks per person
- Prize givings

There is a pay bar on site and if you do not want to stay for lunch the entry fee is reduced to £70.00.

On the day registration will start from 08:00hrs, with shooting commencing from 09:00hrs. **This event is not squadded** so your team can turn up, have breakfast and start shooting as soon as you're ready. Last entries are at 12:00hrs but the later start times are primarily intended for those who have some distance to travel and who prefer not to have to stay overnight on the Friday night.

Payment is by cheque payable to the 'Essex Masonic Clay Shooting Association' (please do not abbreviate to EMCSA). You may also pay by BACS transfer to Account No: 22199823; Sort Code: 40-42-27. If paying individually by BACS please use your name & initials as the reference; i.e., **PGReeves** and then email me to confirm the date on which the money was transferred and the amount.

If your club is collecting the money in and then making one payment on behalf of the whole team please use your Province as the reference; i.e., **PGLBucks** or **PGLEastKent** and again email me with the date the payment was transferred and the names of those for whom you've paid.

Non-Shooters

There is no charge if non-shooters wish to accompany you and enjoy the facilities at West London Shooting School and if they want to join us for lunch the cost is just £10.00 per head).

Shoot Details

The competition is open to all Freemasons who are a subscribing or honorary member of a Lodge or Chapter and their friends and family.

The team scores will be based on the three highest scores in each team. Non-masonic guest teams must confirm at registration who the members are in their team.

Safety & Rules

- The shoot will be run to CPSA / NAMCSS rules.
- Any challenges will be dealt with by the nominated Shoot Panel on the day. Their decision is final.
- Hearing & Eye protection must be worn by everyone (including non-shooters) out on the shooting ground.
- Cartridges: Maximum 28g (1oz) load, no larger than size 6. No home loads.
- Only **FIBRE** cartridges are allowed at the ground.

West London Shooting School has a very well stocked shop on site for all your shooting needs, including cartridges at a competitive price.



Classes of Entry

- Mason - Must be a subscribing or honorary member of a Lodge or Chapter
- Guest - Open
- Lady - Open
- Junior - Open, but must be under 21 on day of competition
- Veteran - Must be a subscribing or honorary member of a Lodge or Chapter and aged 65 or older on the day of the competition.

Prize Categories include:

- Top Masonic Team
- Masonic Team Runners-up
- Top Guest Team
- Guest Team Runners-up
- Top Ladies Team - only awarded if two or more Ladies' Teams have entered.
- Ladies Team Runners-up - only awarded if three or more Ladies' Teams have entered.
- Guest High Gun
- Guest High Gun Runner-up
- Ladies High Gun
- Ladies High Gun Runner-up
- Junior High Gun
- Veteran High Gun
- Masonic High Gun
- Masonic High Gun Runner-up

Any tied scores will be decided by count back on pre-selected stands.

Hotels

The Premier Inn at 362 Uxbridge Road, Hayes, UB4 0HF is a 6 minute drive from the ground and has twin rooms for £56 a night.



By Car

From M40/A40: At the Polish War Memorial Junction take A4180 south towards Hayes and Yeading. After ¼ mile turn right into Sharvel Lane, (opposite the American Golf Course).

From M4: At Junction 3 take A312 north towards Harrow. At the 3rd roundabout after leaving the M4 take the 2nd exit signed A40/M40 and follow for ½ mile. Turn left into Sharvel Lane, (opposite the American Golf Course). You should allow +/- 50 minutes from Central London depending on traffic.

By Train

Take the Central Line to South Ruislip Station. Call for a taxi in advance (020 8845 0055).

Alternatively you can take the Chiltern Turbo from Marylebone to South Ruislip Station.
